### General Assembly- DISEC

The first committee of the General Assembly is the Disarmament and International Security Committee (DISEC). DISEC deals with the issues regarding the promotion, establishment, and subsequent maintenance of global peace while simultaneously working to prevent weapons proliferation. According to Article 26 of United Nations Charter, DISEC's mandate is "to promote the establishment and maintenance of international peace and security with the least diversion for armaments of the world's human and economic resources."

### Security Council

Under the Charter, the Security Council has primary responsibility for the maintenance of international peace and security. It has 15 Members, and each Member has one vote. Under the Charter, all Member States are obligated to comply with Council decisions.

The Security Council takes the lead in determining the existence of a threat to the peace or act of aggression. It calls upon the parties to a dispute to settle it by peaceful means and recommends methods of adjustment or terms of settlement. In some cases, the Security Council can resort to imposing sanctions or even authorize the use of force to maintain or restore international peace and security.

### UNESCO

The United Nations Education, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) is a specialized agency of the United Nations (UN). UNESCO was founded on 16 February 1945; 24 days after the UN came into force, and strives for world peace under the following motto: "Since wars begin in the minds of men, it is in the minds of men that the defenses of peace must be constructed"

UNESCO headquarters are located in Paris (France). Here, most of the Member States have their Permanent Delegation situated, whose delegations are headed by Ambassadors. In addition, all Member States have a National UNESCO Commission; this makes UNESCO unique within the UN. The National Commissions are the connection between UNESCO and different organizations (governmental and non-governmental) that are involved with UNESCO projects. National Commissions are good sources of information on Member States' UNESCO projects in their country and the contributions of the National Commissions they make to the UNESCO organization as a whole.
